WHAT IS MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT)?

Use of medications and therapy to provide a whole-person approach to treating opioid and alcohol-based addictions. Some of the drugs we treat in this program are Heroin, Fentanyl, Oxycontin, Vicodin, Morphine, etc.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

At CommWell Health, you will:

- Work with your doctor to receive the medication that works best for you to block your cravings and effects of opioids.
- Work with your counselor to address any emotional or mental health needs regarding use, like identifying triggers and social supports.

MEDICATION TYPES

Buprenorphine

- Available in strips or pills for oral consumption.

Naltrexone

- Available as an injection or orally.
- Can be used to treat alcohol use disorder or opioid use disorder.

Suboxone (Buprenorphine + Naloxone)

- Available in strips or pills for oral consumption.
- Can be used to treat both opioid and alcohol use disorder.
